What is Grandview Community Dance?

Grandview Community Dance is an open level ongoing six-week dance course open to the parents of Grandview Preparatory School students and adults in the Boca Raton community. An open-level class is appropriate for beginners to professionals.

What style of dance will be taught?

The style of dance will vary with each session depending on interest. Styles can include jazz, modern, ballet, musical theatre dance, stretch & strengthen, and yoga.

What should I wear?

Shoes: Street shoes are not to be worn in the dance room. Dance shoes or bare feet are recommended for all classes. Slip-on or lace-up jazz shoes, jazz sneakers, ballet slippers, and teaching sandals are all appropriate dance shoe choices.

Clothing: Clothing that you are able to comfortably move in, that is also form fitting, is best. Jazz or yoga pants, leotard, tights, t-shirt...etc.

What is the cost?

The rate for the six-week session is \$72 (\$12/class) for once-a-week or the discounted price of \$135 for twice-a-week if paid on the first day. 100% of the proceeds go directly to building the dance program.
